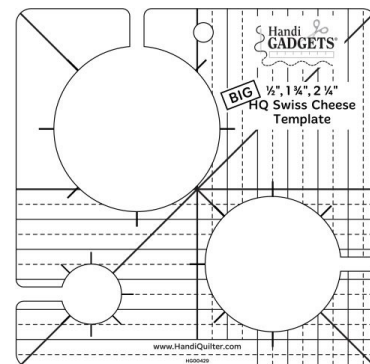

**Tomahawk Sew N Vac is starting it's own Ruler Club. We have 16 different hand sized rulers in stock. Each monthly meeting will have you using two different rulers to make designs on a quilt block so that you can take samples home with you. There is no charge for class, you buy one ruler at \$22.00 and get 1 free.**

**The club will meet once a month during 2 different sessions. You only need to come to one session a month as the same material will be covered at both just different time-frames to accommodate various schedules. One will be the third Wednesday of the month from 1-3 p.m. The second will be the third Saturday of the month from 10 a.m. - 12 p.m. (with the exception of November due to our Handi Quilter Educator Event) It will be a come as you can and leave when you are done format. I will have samples and be able to help you. We will have machines setup with a ruler foot, but you can bring your own machine with the correct ruler foot if you'd like. By the end of this club, you will know how to use rulers, have a nice sample library to help you remember designs, and have a good selection of rulers to use at home or on the long arm machine.**

**Class Description:**

**We will be making the pumpkin completely in the hoop. You will learn to make the pumpkin in three hooping. The text will be add using the edit on your machine.**

**Provided by Student: Material for pumpkin front and back:  
3 pieces of fabric for the front 7x**



11 (Can make your pumpkin all one color if you want)  
3 pieces of fabric for the back 7x11  
Small piece of brown for stem and green for leaf  
Thread to match your material

### Autumn Flag or Table Runner

Intermediate Difficulty Level

Maximum Class Size: 3-4

Class Description:

Will be making 6 panels in the hoop, then joining them together with sewing machine to make a yard flag, table runner or a door hanging, you choice to put together. The block is quilted when you are finished so will not need for additional batting.

Supplies

Provided by Instructor: Stabilizer, batting

Provided by Student: 6 – 7 x 9 inch background of panels (can be one color or two color of 3 each or a different color for each panel.)

Border strips: 2 – 2.5 x 12 inch end borders

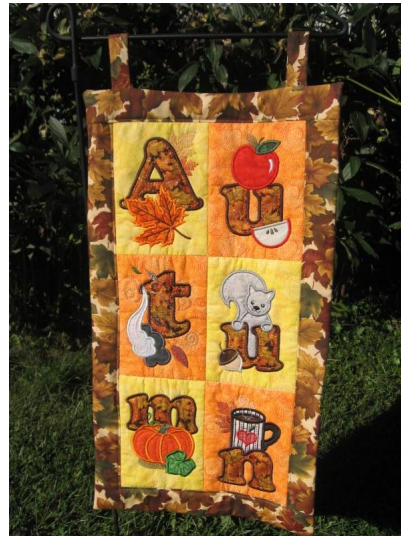
2 – 2.5 x 26 inch side borders (can bring longer strips and cut to size there)

Backing: 15 x 26 (can bring larger piece and cut to size there)

Scraps of fabric for applique, or fat quarters.

Thread to match you material (there is some thread at class to use, but limited to color. You can purchase thread at class.

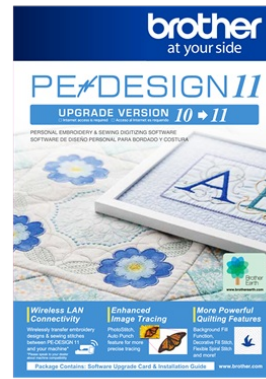
## Embroidery Software: Learning the Basics
